On February 22, 2016 a presentation was made to the Williston Select Board requesting that they approve fees for certain services provided by the Williston Police Department. Police personnel presented information regarding the costs for providing three different services to members of the public that are in response to other entity/agency requirements. Ultimately, these services cause Williston officers to divert their attention from other higher priority policing issues.

On Monday March 7, 2016, the Williston Select Board approved the police department charging fees for performing vehicle identification number (VIN) inspections, civilian fingerprints for employment or other purposes, and for producing official identifications for active and retired public safety officials.

The fees were put in place effective immediately and are as follows:

Civilian Fingerprints - \$25 for all requests except for Williston residents that are in need of fingerprints for local volunteer activities

Vehicle ID Verifications - \$5 per vehicle identification number inspected

Photo ID's for Public Safety Officials - \$25 for retired officials and \$15 for active officials. Fees are waived for all Williston municipal public safety officials.

Unless otherwise approved by the Williston Police Department, fees will need to be paid at the time of service and must be in the form of check or cash. The police department is not set up to accept credit or debit cards.
