1. Last Quarter:

- Finalized promotional process; Promoted Officer Joshua Moore to Sergeant
- Graduation of Officer Ducharme, Vermont Police Academy
 - Finalized training for Ofc. Ducharme and moved her into being a solo officer
- Sgt. Claffy participated in the 4th of July Committee Meetings and has formulated traffic direction plan for the parade
- Conducted a recruitment cycle and initially identified 2 potential candidates, however they were not offered positions after conducting background
- Our dispatch schedule has moved from M-F, 7 AM thru 11 PM to M-Sun, 7 AM thru 7 PM on an experimental basis of 4 months. Increased daytime weekend activity suggests making this change.
- Attended the Annual Joint Vermont Chief's and Sheriff's meeting in June
- Participated in training for the Vermont ALERT System
- First Shift bidding process was conducted for Patrol Staff as part of new contract – done with no significant issues
- Ordered a second stationary speed display sign with GHSP Grant Funds
- Implemented a uniform transition to a more functional shirt/pant combination for use with our external protective vests that we anticipate will help in controlling uniform costs in the future
- Significant events
 - Hazardous Materials incident at recycling facility, Avenue C causing evacuation and road closures
 - Suspected Hazardous Substance at Federal facility on Harvest Lane causing large multi-agency response
 - Demonstrations/Protests of Vermont Gas Project has begun again for this year's construction season
 - Noise Ordinance issue with North Country Sportsman's Club and resulting lawsuit
 - Several Officers participated in the annual Law Enforcement Torch Run – coordinated by Sergeant Justin Huizenga
 - Sgt. Scott Graham and Officer Keith Gonyeau reach the 15 year anniversary milestone working for the Williston Police Department

2. Upcoming Quarter:

- Have a successful 4th of July Parade that will consist of a "Fill the Police Cruiser" event to help the Williston Food Shelf
- Finalize steps to configure the ALERT Notification system in conjunction with the Department of Emergency Management with the State of Vermont.
 - Begin developing policy
 - Plan community marketing of system
- Continue efforts to identify candidates to fill current vacancies

- Begin processes for replacing equipment identified in the Capital Budget
- Finalize receiving quotes for building maintenance project to finish ceiling on the second floor unfinished planning/operations room
