Pursuant to Article VI and Article X of the Williston Motor Vehicle and Traffic Ordinance the Williston Selectboard will hold a public hearing at the Williston Town Hall Meeting Room on Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at 8:00 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comment on proposed changes to Appendix B and D of the Ordinance.

Proposed changes include the following:

- Appendix B: Remove two stop signs located on Zephyr Road at the intersection with Day Lane.
- Appendix B: Remove two stop signs located on Blair Park Road at the intersection with Paul Street.
- Appendix B: Add one stop sign on Paul Street at the intersection with Blair Park Road.
- Appendix D: Create a no parking zone on the northeast corner of the Zephyr Road intersection.

If adopted, the amendments may become effective 60 days after the public hearing and vote by the Selectboard.

Notice is hereby given that any ordinance or amendment thereto adopted by the Town of Williston may be disapproved by a vote of a majority of the qualified voters at an annual or special meeting as provided in 24 V.S.A. §1973.
