

ALCOHOL - PUBLIC PLACES ORDINANCE

It is hereby ordained by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Williston as follows:

1. Definitions

As used in this ordinance the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- a. Open beverage container - a container, bottle, can or vessel containing malt or vinous beverages or spirituous liquors which is open.
- b. Public Place - a public place shall mean any playground, park or school property or other place open temporarily or permanently to the public for general circulation of vehicles or pedestrians within the Town of Williston.

2. Prohibition

Except as authorized in subsection c hereof:

- a. No person shall have constructive or actual possession of an open beverage container in any public place or in any motor vehicle located in a public place.
- b. No person shall consume the contents of an open beverage container in any public place or in any motor vehicle in a public place.
- c. Notwithstanding subparagraphs a and b hereof, the Board of Selectmen may give specific advance written approval for possession and consumption from open beverage containers, including beer kegs, within Town parks.

3. Penalties

Persons convicted of violating this section shall be fined not more than \$200.
