Housing Trust Fund Ordinance

Pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1971 the Williston Selectboard will hold a public hearing at the Town Hall Meeting Room on Tuesday, June 20, 2017 at 7:30 p.m. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comment on proposed new Housing Trust Fund Ordinance.

The purpose of the Ordinance is to establish a Housing Trust Fund for the promotion, retention, and creation of long-term affordable housing for very low or low income households. Below is a listing of the contents:

Article III:	Definitions
Article IV:	Establishment of Housing Trust Fund
Article V:	Management of Housing Trust Fund
Article VI:	Distribution and Use of Housing Trust Fund Assets

If adopted, the amendments may become effective 60 days after the public hearing and vote by the Selectboard.

Notice is hereby given that any ordinance or amendment thereto adopted by the Town of Williston may be disapproved by a vote of a majority of the qualified voters at an annual or special meeting as provided in 24 V.S.A. §1973.
