The legal voters of the Town of Williston are hereby notified to meet on November 3, 2020, at Vermont Army National Guard Armory located at 7846 Williston Road at 7:00 AM, at which time the polls will open, until 7:00 PM, at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following article:

Article 1:	<p>Shall the bonds of the Town of Williston in an amount not to exceed Two Million and 00/100 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) be issued to finance the replacement of watermains, pipes and appurtenances within the road rights-of-way of White Birch Lane, Lamplite Lane, Pine Lane and Aspen Lane, to connect the newly installed watermains and pipes to water service lines along White Birch Lane, Lamplite Lane, Pine Lane and Aspen Lane, and to pay related professional fees and project costs?</p> <p>If in favor of the bond issue, make a cross (X) in this square <input type="checkbox"/>.</p> <p>If opposed of the bond issue, make a cross (X) in this square <input type="checkbox"/>.</p>

IF YOU PREFER NOT TO VOTE IN PERSON, your completed ballot must be returned to the Town Clerk’s Office by NOON on Monday, November 2nd, 2020 or dropped off at the Vermont Army National Guard Armory located at 7846 Williston Road between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Tuesday, November 3rd. IF YOU PREFER TO VOTE IN PERSON, you may do so on November 3rd between 7:00 o’clock AM and 7:00 o’clock PM.

PUBLIC INFORMATION HEARING: A public information hearing will be held using the videoconference platform Zoom on _____, 2020 at 7 o’clock in the afternoon (7:00 PM). A separate public notice of the information hearing will be posted in two public locations in Town at least 10 days in advance of the information hearing.

HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE: There is no deadline to register to vote. You will be able to register to vote on the day of the election. You can register prior to the day of the election by visiting the Town Clerk’s office or going online to olvr.vermont.gov
